Michael A. Calhoun

Mike Calhoun has been a member of the Canadian Kennel Club since 1975 and was the owner of Zoon-Monere Training School for 15 years. Following an illness, he closed the school and now trains only with obedience clubs in his area. While training Dobermans, Bouvier des Flandres and German Shepherd Dogs in obedience, tracking & schutzhund, Mike also found time to offer classes in Quebec, Ontario, New York and Vermont. Mike Calhoun has been judging for 16 years, the SPORT of Obedience taking him across Canada, parts of the United States and into Bermuda. Mike has the utmost respect for Juniors and Seniors in his ring, doing his best to help people relax so they may give their best routine on the day. "Do you like the changes seen in the Sport?" "Yes, clubs are improving in their Trials Presentations each year, most now have fully matted rings.....almost standard in Canada and United States for the indoor trials." "What of the new classes now offered?" "Handlers' now have many more titles that may be earned, a win/win situation for all. This should help in keeping the exhibitor interested in Obedience."

Robert Denis

My wife and I have been breeding and exhibiting Shih-tzu under the Lotus prefix since the early nineties. Shortly afterwards I was honored with the opportunity to go into partnership with R. William Taylor and the late Nigel Aubrey-Jones of the St. Aubrey Elsdon Pekingese. The latest special to be campaigned in partnership with R. William Taylor was Multi BIS BISS A/C Ch. St. Aubrey Jubilation of Elsdon. He retired and remains Canada's All time Top Best in Show winning Pekingese and All time Top Best in Show winning Toy. To have owner handled "Bobby" to his very first Best in Show will always remain a special memory. I have been involved in judging since 2007 and started with the Toy group and have now moved to the Non Sporting Group. Early in my career I was honored to be asked to judge Sweepstakes and both the Canadian Shih-tzu national Specialty as well as the Pekingese Club of America National Specialty.

Charlotte McGowan

I started in purebred dogs as a child when I won tickets to a dog show in a writing contest. My first breed was Shelties and I had these for 37 years. I also bred Dandie Dinmont Terriers and my Ch, Charlieshope Au Courant was BB at the DDTCA and at Montgomery County KC as well as being a top producer. For the last 20 odd years I have bred Papillons and have bred 45 champions to date including Specialty and group winners. I am a senior judge for AKC judging 5 groups. I have judged quite a few national specialties and have judged at both Westminster and the AKC show. I continue to breed and show my Papillons and look forward to showing my new Affenpinscher.

Dr. Gerard C. Penta

An AKC approved judge for thirty-eight years, Dr. Penta is approved to judge all Terrier breeds, all Non-Sporting breeds, all Working breeds, most Sporting breeds, two Toy breeds and Best in Show. He has officiated at shows on four continents and has had the privilege of

judging many national and regional specialty shows throughout the USA. Dr. Penta judged the Louisville Kennel Club's first televised Terrier Group when the Louisville show was the largest show in the United States. In January of 2005 he had the honor of judging some of the Non-Sporting breeds at the prestigious AKC/Eukanuba National Championship Show. In his business and professional life, Dr. Penta owns and manages a small real estate business, and has retired from his position as professor of education at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. He is married to June A. Penta, a retired art teacher and AKC judge. The Pentas reside in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, USA.

June A. Penta

Mrs. June Penta owned, bred and exhibited Afghan Hounds and Shih Tzu from the mid-1960's to the mid-1970's. During those years she was the breeder or owner of a number of AKC Champions, including a Field Champion Afghan Hound. Her Shih Tzu were exhibited under the Spring Valley prefix.

Mrs. Penta, an AKC approved judge for thirty-five years, has judged many regional and national specialty shows across the United States. She has had the honor of having been selected to judge the Shih Tzu National Specialty Show five times. She feels that specialty shows are the most challenging and satisfying of judging assignments. Mrs. Penta has also judged at the prestigious Westminster Kennel Club Show on three occasions. In addition to judging assignments throughout the USA, Mrs. Penta has judged in Canada, Mexico, South America, Asia and Europe.

Marion Postgate

Marion Postgate is a CKC Licensed judge of the Toy and Non-Sporting groups and all obedience and rally classes, judging in both Canada and the US. She bred Schipperkes on a limited basis, under the prefix Cantymere (Perm. Reg.), and also has owned and exhibited Rottweilers. She taught obedience classes at all levels for fifty years. She served on the CKC Canine Good Neighbour Committee, and is a strong proponent of that program, as well as the CKC Rally Committee. Currently she is a member of the CKC Obedience Council and EOC Committee. Ms Postgate has studied and lectured on dog structure and movement, as well as dog behaviour, since the 1970s. She taught English, and is an accomplished amateur classical musician, playing the piano and violin. She is married, and has an adult son and daughter.

Jacqueline Rusby

Jacqueline has been judging for more than 22 years, 18 years licensed, and judges all breeds. She is a former breeder of all varieties of Poodles and is a five-time Pedigree Award winner. She is a past president of the Hochelaga Kennel Club and the Mount Royal Toy Dog Fanciers and is currently the conformation director for the Ottawa Valley Poodle Club. She is a member of the American Dog Judges Institute. Over the years she has enjoyed participating in Obedience Trials as well as Conformation Shows. Before retiring she was self-employed and president of an international company. Her life has been one of great travel, having lived on most of the continents of the world at some time, either with her father or her husband. Her travels now take her judging in Australia, Bahamas, Canada, Chile, Mexico, New Zealand, South Africa and USA.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

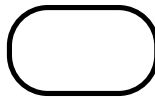

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

A spayed/neutered dog may be entered in the Brace/Team classes, and must be entered in an Altered class or Exhibition only.
Exhibition Only: All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades as provided for in the premium list.
Stud Dog: Stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership need not be identical. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular Class. Dogs entered in Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch: Same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get class. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

Altered Class: Dogs who have been sexually altered, over 6 months of age. This class will be judged after the judging of the Best of Breed in the Regular classes. There will be a class for males and a class for females.

Award of Merit: this award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. One Award of Merit is offered for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

SCHIPPERKE SWEEPSTAKES

Judge: Barbara duPree, Kemptonville, ON

Classes (Sexes divided) 6 - 9 months, 9 -12 months, 12-18 months.

All Schipperkes between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the day of the Specialty shall be eligible to compete regardless of place of birth. All Schipperkes entered in the sweepstakes must be also entered in a regular class in the Schipperke Specialty.

Veterans: 7-9 years, 10+ years

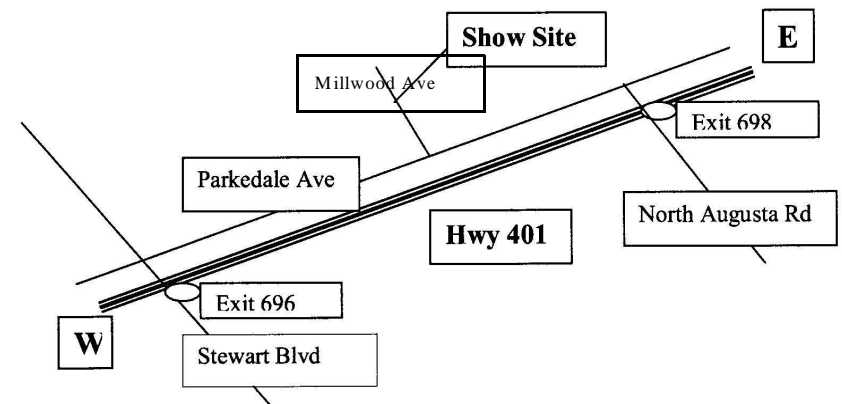
GENERAL RULES

1. Building will accept dogs and equipment after 6:00 pm. Thursday.
2. Building will open at 7:00 am Friday, Saturday and Sunday and close at midnight Friday and Saturday. Exhibitors must vacate the building 1 hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
3. Intransit area available.
4. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.
5. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.
6. TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
7. DIANA EDWARDS SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
8. Acknowledgement of Entry and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
9. The person accompanying the dog must show Acknowledgement of Entry before the dog is allowed in the show, and unless a dog is entered officially, it will not be allowed in the show precincts. Show Precincts is the whole Memorial Centre building proper plus anything within ten feet of the outdoor rings as well as the gymnasium at St. Lawrence College.
10. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
11. D.E.S.S. and the T.I.K.O. Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
12. Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where there is a conflict between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules, that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
13. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.
14. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
15. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
16. We will have someone clean up during the show times, but remember they cannot be everywhere at once. Your co-operation in cleaning up after your dog is much appreciated.

PLEASE NOTE

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)

How do I get to the show site?



From the east:

Take Exit 698 off Highway 401, turn left onto PARKEDALE AVENUE, proceed to MILLWOOD AVE., turn right and turn right again on MAGEDOMA DRIVE immediately behind Canadian Tire

From the west:

Take Exit 696 off Highway 401, turn left (over the overpass) on STEWART BLVD., proceed to PARKEDALE AVENUE, turn right, proceed east along PARKEDALE to MILLWOOD AVENUE, turn left, turn right on MAGEDOMA DRIVE, immediately behind Canadian Tire.
